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NEW WORLD SPECIES OF THE GENUS CALLISCELIO ASHMEAD (HYMENOPTERA, PLATYGASTRIDAE, SCELIONINAE)

Calliscelio amadoi Chen & Johnson, sp. n.

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The genus *Calliscelio* Ashmead is presumed to be a diverse group of parasitoids of the eggs of crickets (Orthoptera: Gryllidae). A least one species has been found to be an important factor in depressing cricket pest populations. The New World species of *Calliscelio* are revised. Forty-two species are recognized, 3 are redescribed and 38 are described as new. Four species are treated as junior synonyms of *Calliscelio rubriclavus* (Ashmead).

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
